With her rhythmic textile works, **Meghan Spielman** bridges generations through inherited materials and time-honoured craftsmanship, while **Alexander Grawoig** immortalises memories of song and sound through paint and collage.

**Emily Kirby's** elliptical paintings explore cultural and individual connections that honour ancestral and natural worlds. Rooted in the Cornish landscape, **Ed Burkes'** expansive canvases speak both to personal experience and universal resonance.

This exhibition invites visitors to consider art's ability to hold memory, embody place, and transmit inspiration across time.

Whether through concept or craft, these works illustrate the profound interconnections binding people, art, and the environments they orbit, tracing quiet constellations of meaning through the spaces we call home.
